The loss of a great actor

No more than 20 minutes ago, an updated report arrived on the kidnapping of Ryan Gosling, Emma Stone and Timothée Chalamet. Who Really is Fidel Castro?

When asking the question: “What do you think of Fidel Castro?” the responses can vary much more than you would presume. Some people, like Huber Matos and Osmany Cienfuegos, will answer by calling him ruthless, power-hungry, selfish, and cold-blooded. However, asking the same question to Celia Sanchez and Che Guevara will result in answers like “A symbol for the disadvantaged” and “A symbol of hope and resilience” respectively. How and why does this happen? How does Castro become two people at once?

Revolutionary Hero (Che Guevara, Celia Sanchez)

Both Celia Sanchez, a close friend of Castro, and Che Guevara, Castro’s right-hand man argue that Castro is a good man who improved the nation. Celia Sanchez stated, “Fidel was a symbol of hope for the disadvantaged.” Che Guevara famously said, “Cuba was made a better place by Castro, Free Castro!” These claims are not unfounded, as Cuba has gone through great reforms in Castro’s reign. For example, according to a defender taking part in the Castro V Prosecution case (ICC), Cuban literacy rates grew from 50% to 99%, 13% of Cuban GDP is spent on education, and Cuba’s healthcare and social programs are ranked as one of the best in Latin America (also proven by sources). Castro and his reforms are idolized by these people, and Celia stated in her testimony “He always wanted to help people; it’s mind-blowing how people can turn things and look at him this way”. Castro also mentioned in his testimony “What does a criminal want? What’s best for his nation?”

Ruthless Dictator (Huber Matos, Osmany Cienfuegos)

Huber Matos was a member of the party and a close friend of Castro, but Huber eventually left when the party began adopting Communist ideals. Castro labeled him as a traitor and unfairly sentenced him to 20 years in prison. When asked about how his conditions in prison were, he answered, “I was starved, I was punched, I was tortured, it was terrible!”. He also said this when asked about Fidel, “he said Cuba would be democratic, and he lied, he manipulated all of us.” Osmany Cienfuegos is the brother of Camilo Cienfuegos, a prominent revolutionary and good friend of Castro. However, as time went on, Castro began fearing that Camilo’s personal popularity would overtake his, so he inexplicably killed him. Osmany mentioned in his testimony “I urge you to punish Castro... over 14,000 have been killed by Castro and his party.” He also stated, “He chose to kill my brother, enough is enough.”

Who is the true Castro?

Fidel Castro is a master in manipulation, able to change his appearance and personality to whatever situation seems fit. This mastery of manipulation is what helped him stay in power for so many years, and what brings people like Celia and Che to defend him to this day. But, who is the true Castro? Is he ruthless or empathetic? Is he Manipulative or truth-speaking? Is he a ruthless dictator or a revolutionary hero?

As the United States struggles with the aftermath of the September 11 attacks, the U.S. Senate has quickly taken steps to form a path towards recovery and reconciliation. Senators molded a comprehensive approach to restore peace and ensure the safety of all its citizens, with the now released resolution paper.

During the past hours, the nation has witnessed acts of hatred against Arab-American communities, which highlights the gravity of the situation. In Brooklyn, New York, reports of verbal and physical attacks have surfaced, reflecting the pain and anger felt by many. And yet, individuals like Charlie Sahadi have received aggressive comments, which include "Go back to your own [...] country," yelled by Stephanie Jankowitz at the Arab owner of a barber shop. "Let just one of them smile at me today. I'll spit in their face." Aggression has been seen through actions. A Post reporter witnessed two men driving a car with a sign taped to the rear window that said: "Kill all Palestinians." In response, the Senate has been working on several initiatives designed to address both the immediate and long-term needs of the nation in a resolution paper. Government funds have been redirected to aid restoration efforts and support the communities most impacted by the attacks.

Understanding the importance of community engagement, the Senate has enhanced its collaboration with non-profit

organizations. These partnerships aim to provide crucial services and promote dialogue among diverse groups.

In relation with security measures, collaborating with the Security Council, the Senate has focused on making airplane cabins safer, a move aimed at preventing future threats and restoring public confidence in air traveling.

To directly respond to the surge in hate crimes, a hotline for reporting attacks against Muslim Americans has been established. Media outlets have been encouraged to play a critical role in this effort. A nationwide campaign across radio, newspapers, and television seeks to promote messages of unity and understanding, challenging the stereotypes of division, fear, and anger.

Protection for places of worship has also been prioritized, with increased security measures for mosques and other religious sites.

The world trusted the brilliant minds that make up the Senate, and indeed they have not disappointed. They debated solutions for the people, for the country, and for the whole world. That will come down to history as one of the greatest acts of union the world has ever seen.

DELEGATE INTERVIEWS ON SOLUTIONS

Delegate Interviews

I, as a Press Corps reporter decided to interview four delegates from the OAS committee to get their perspective on the topic and collect more information about the solutions and what would be some of the pros and cons of each proposed solution by the delegates in the committee. I will be sharing my interviews with the delegate of Argentina and the delegate of the Bahamas.

Delegate of Argentina Interview:

What are the proposed solutions that the committee has stated and what are some of the proposals your delegation has stated regarding elections and fraud? “Make an online way on voting to prevent voting fraud for citizens to trust more.” “Make immigrants in relation with the voter permit institutions to renew and to expand in rural areas for the people who cannot go to a city.” “The committee has also been talking about a solution that my delegation proposed: making a hotline. This would be applied in rural areas in a traditional way and with will not include technology since rural areas don’t have much of a development technology.” “Independent government body: many bordering countries influence elections and the chair has

recommended to focus on preventing that to keep sovereignty in countries.” “The chair informed the committee to focus more on voter turnout and voter trust because the committee has focused a lot on border fraud. My delegation agrees with that. The delegate of the Bahamas has mentioned that: what will happen with immigrants?” “My delegation proposes to make a voter institution in bordering countries. For example: immigrants in Mexico will be able to have their voter permit renewed by creating voter institutions in bordering countries.” *What are some of the counterarguments when discussing the solutions? For example: if someone doesn’t like the idea of online voting, what would be a counterargument for that?* “Me delegation was the first to propose that and there were some delegations that didn’t agree with that because it was easy to manipulate. My delegation did some research about some companies and organizations that have an excellent reputation such as Erritec and Panasonic which include biometric systems such as iris scanner, fingerprint, and facial recognition. Me delegation mentioned that those companies have an excellent reputation and it’s very hard for them to fail or for their system to be hacked.” *What are some of the*

organizations that your delegation or others have mentioned to solve this problem? “My delegation has researched about companies such as Erritec, Panasonic, RIS, and some NGOs that would help with awareness and some research analyses, the IFES and Integral Electoral Project.”

Delegate of the Bahamas Interview:

Can your delegation give me a brief overview of the topic discussed and what are some of the solutions that the committee has mentioned to resolve the topic? “The topic is about voter turnout: people not wanting to vote, fraud in elections: the elections are bought, and trusting elections.” “Some of the solutions: use independent government organizations to investigate corruption in countries, use NGOs, use hotlines for people if they see any target of corruption. The

The interview with the delegate of the Bahamas was more about election fraud, ways of preventing it, the use of certain organizations, and examples of corruption in governments. It also discussed the similar solutions that the delegate of Argentina mentioned with some type of hotline or system in developed and undeveloped areas to prevent corruption.

The other two interviews with the delegate of Mexico and the delegate of Trinidad and Tobago are, in summary: create workshops and collaborative community funds; countries’ funds would be based on GDP and educational finance; create a server for each country that would be unique in different ways; make elections simpler with the UN, NGOs, and organizations like IFES, etc.



committee has also considered doing a videotape when the votes are being counted to promote trust and have no corruption.” “There’s also discrimination in voting and there are NGOs that help people in discriminated communities to help them vote because there are places where black people aren’t allowed or cannot vote.” What are some of the organizations that your delegation or others have proposed to help solve the problem like the independent government organizations and NGOs? “Some organizations are the FES and the Brac, these organizations are about election fraud.” What are some examples of countries or governments that have been accused of corruption or fraud in the election? “The U.S. in the elections of 2016: there was an investigation in the Trump election, saying that the government’s elections were a fraud.” “There were also accusations of election fraud in Mexico and in Venezuela with the president, Madero.”

Conclusions:

The interview with the delegate of Argentina showed me the online voting system proposal in a much more detailed manner and showcased the committee’s corroborated proposals during the interview, leading me to conclude that some of the solutions would work.

Crisis Resolutions

Some of the main clauses in the preambulatory regarding Scientology Church involvement in the government are:

Alarmed by the loss of satellite communication. Aware of the influence popular figures may have on society.

Fully aware of the distrust the citizens will have towards the government due to this issue.

Emphasizing the government’s corruption.

Compromising the country’s security and safety.

The operative clauses:

The well-being of the citizens.

Implement medical and psychological aid for the affected individuals.

Give updates about investigations made.

Implement short term solutions and calm citizens down.

There was an update! Following the corruption scandals Mexico and five other FIFA members made, the organization (FIFA) has found itself in big trouble. Players began to protest after initiating the boycott, this has disrupted some important aspects of the World Cup preparation process.

The boycott went to extremes; players began to make symbolic gestures like refusing to play in mandatory qualification matches, training, medical assessments, and sponsor committees. These absences may change the whole outcome of the biggest sporting event in the world, and could deeply affect FIFA as a whole.

How could it affect FIFA? These protests go beyond just the field, this could affect the sponsors. Which means it could affect the profit and different aspects of the financial aspect. With the 2026 World Cup around the corner, the possibility of the World Cup being canceled would lead fans, teams, players, and sponsors to a state of confusion and anger.

The protest got out of hand when star players like Leonel Messi, Rodri, Robert Lewandowski, Mohamrd Salah, Jude Bellingham, Kevin de Bruyne, Erling Haaland, and Kylian Mbappe showed disagreement towards FIFA. These players are the best of the best in the world, which led FIFA to feel more pressure.

According to Vivian C, "In response to the crisis, the players' union demanded nothing short of a complete overhaul of FIFA's policies. Additionally, they called for the establishment of an independent body tasked with addressing the legitimate concerns raised by the players. The demand for reform signaled a pivotal moment in the history of international football, with players taking a collective stand for transparency, fairness, and a more inclusive representation within the sport's governing structures" (Vivian C, 2024).

What did the committee think about this? After spectating the committee, I came across interesting ideas. The whole committee was in favor of searching for a new place to host the World Cup. This is because the committee decided that Canada and the USA could not host since Mexico changed the whole trajectory of the process of the World Cup. Since the USA and Canada will not be hosting, they will get a reward, which was a solution offered by the Canadian representative, which is an automatic pass to the next 3 world cups (2026, 2030, and 2034). This was seen as fair to the committee because they are potentially taking away a massive economic boost for both countries.

To conclude, this experience of being inside a very important committee has opened my eyes to the financial part of the sport we all love, but has also made me wonder, is this sport about passion or money?

Final Resolutions

Friday, 5:40 PM, Session 5, Press Conference. In the press conference, delegates from the committee expressed their united opinions through questions that I the reporter asked them. The committee was on the right track. Delegates from Qatar, Pakistan, Ecuador, and Japan expressed the committee's opinion on the issues of prisoners and Amazon workers. IMMUNS 2024 was shaping up to be a success for the Human Rights Council. Saturday would be the day for the writing and presentation of the final resolution paper. What could possibly go wrong?

Saturday, 9:30 AM, Session 6, I enter the classroom ready to report on the final clauses. What was inside was nothing near a classroom. I enter a room of chaos. The delegates went from talking about solutions to death. What had happened? A double Crisis had just happened! As the crisis paper is given to me my jaw drops. Jeff Besos, Owner of Amazon the greatest business in the world had fired 1,541,000 company workers 41% of the company labor workers. But the second Crisis was way worse. Jeff Besos had then been assassinated. He had been shot in his car and was now dead. This was truly a crisis. The delegations of Qatar, Ecuador, Brazil, China, and Iran were blurting out possible ways of solving this. This crisis demanded an unmoderated debate. CIA! Private Investigators! Safety! Rights! Workers! Economy! Safety! All these words were spoken in overlap by delegates.

Time was running out. All these accumulated problems from the crisis flooded the clause papers as the delegates were trying to propose the best solution possible.

The delegates of Pakistan and Qatar were voted as sponsors and the whole committee and the chair voted for the resolution to pass. Now it was up to a secretariat member to decide if these resolutions would pass. And after a few minutes of high tension, the resolution paper for the crisis was successful! Delegates cheered as they had created a solution to deal with the crisis.

But they might have been forgetting something. The main purpose for the meeting of the Human Rights Council in IMMUNS 2024. Addressing the rights and freedoms of prisoners. 27 minutes left till the end of the final session and they had to get together against time to create the final resolution paper.

After 20 minutes of full debating the clauses were done. This time the sponsors were Pakistan and Japan and again these clauses were approved by the delegates and chair. The secretariat reenters the room to approve the final resolution paper. If tensions were high last time this time they are 10x higher. The secretariat reads the resolution paper and approves it! Immense claps fill the room. The IMMUNS 2024 Human Rights Council successfully found solutions for the rights of prisoners and the crisis presented. Now it is time for these solutions to be placed in the world.

NORTH KOREAN NUCLEAR BOMB TEST
