## IMMUNS DRESS CODE

● **Zoom:** Although this simulation will be held online, we still require proper dress code as described below. In addition, we will also require that cameras be on at all times and microphones muted except called upon.

● **Women:** They must always wear formal clothing. This includes a knee length skirt and formal blouse, dress, or suit with adequate shoes. No tennis shoes, spaghetti straps or short skirts allowed.

● **Men:** They must wear formal clothing at all times. This is limited to a suit. Men should always wear their jackets and ties (except if the chair considers the room is too warm), with formal shoes. No white socks or tennis shoes are allowed.

**Note:** Some traditional attire that is representative of the delegate's country may also be worn, as long as it looks appropriate and is considered traditionally formal clothing.

- Breaking the dress code will result in warnings within the committee.
- In the case of a delegate dressing inappropriately or too revealingly, they will receive a warning for the day, but if they dress similarly the next day, they will not be allowed inside the committee.
